

Antisemitism statement

London School of Commerce & IT (LSCI) is committed to ensure safety of its students and staff from all kind of harassment and bullying while they are studying or working in its campus.

To strengthen its policy of safety and wellbeing for all its students and staff, LSCI, hereby adopts the definition of Antisemitism as defined by International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance (IHRA)'s through the following statement:

“Antisemitism is a certain perception of Jews, which may be expressed as hatred toward Jews. Rhetorical and physical manifestations of antisemitism are directed toward Jewish or non-Jewish individuals and/or their property, toward Jewish community institutions and religious facilities.”¹

LSCI will do everything possible to protect all its students, including the Jews, from all kinds of harm - physical or emotional while they are on campus. Any kind of bullying or antisocial behaviour shown towards any of its students or staff will be dealt with appropriately.
